Robert Maynard Nevins, 83, of Charlotte, MI, passed away peacefully on Sunday, September 11, 2016 in Charlotte. Bob was born July 26, 1933, in Lansing, the son of Robert Henry and Ila Morrine (Frever) Nevins. He graduated from Charlotte High School before enlisting in the U.S. Navy and proudly serving during the Korean Conflict. Bob worked in several business ventures throughout his life, most notably managing the Insider Carwash in Lansing for 20 years and, most recently, as the Customer Service Manager at Team One in Charlotte.

Bob loved sports of all kinds. As a young man his favorite hobby was fast pitch softball, managing and playing for Wertz Implement Co. of Charlotte and also umpiring all over the state. After his softball years he turned towards golf. He loved playing golf, making seven hole-in-ones in his lifetime and was the Charlotte County Club champion in 1982. He was a permanent fixture in Charlotte High School athletics. Many will remember his "emotional comments" on the sidelines. Bob was the head crew member for the Charlotte High School Football chain crew. He held the Downs Box for every game in his 44 year career, missing only one game. He was also an official timer for CHS home track meets and was one-time president of Charlotte Pony Football League. Bob loved fishing, playing poker with his friends, cheering for Central Michigan University Football, and, above all, his four sons and many grandchildren.

Bob is survived by his sons; Robb (Vicki) Nevins of Dimondale, Rick (Toni) Nevins, Ryan Nevins, both of Charlotte, and Rory (Amanda) Nevins of Lake Isabella; 8 grandchildren; 11 great-grandchildren; and brothers, Roy Nevins and Gerald Fetterman. He was predeceased by his parents and two brothers, Rex and Ray Nevins.

Funeral Services will be at 11:00 a.m. on Wednesday, September 14, 2016 at Pray Funeral Home, Charlotte, with Rev. Duane Royston officiating. Interment will follow at Maple Hill Cemetery, Charlotte.
