August 10, 1924 - August 31, 2001

Spotts, Robert 77 of Charlotte, Michigan, formerly of Montague, died Friday, August 31, 2001 at the St. Lawrence Dimondale Center after a lengthy illness. Mr. Spotts was born August 10, 1924 in Charlotte, the son of Ray and Gladys (Casler) Spotts. He was the owner and operator of Insty Prints in Muskegon until he retired in 1994. He was a member of St. John's Episcopal Church in Charlotte, the Brookfield Masonic Lodge, Maple City VFW Post 2406 and the American Legion Post #42 in Charlotte. Mr. Spotts served with the U.S. Marine Corps during World War II and was awarded the Purple Heart. His wife Carol (Stratton) preceded him in death in August 30, 1995. Graveside services will be held 1:00 PM Wednesday at Maple Hill Cemetery in Charlotte, with Rev. Dr. Carol Spangenberg officiating.
