Roger Lee Newcomb, 85, of Charlotte, a passionately independent, generous spirit with a heart of gold, died Thursday, November 17, 2022 in Jackson, MI. Roger was born October 23, 1937 in Huntington, WV, the son of George and Jewel (Foster) Newcomb. Family was central to Roger's life. They often traveled together to the U.P., where they enjoyed their cabin in Paradise, MI. In later years, they would winter in Florida, where Roger developed many new friendships. He was always a friendly, outgoing man, who attracted many friends to his circle, and he was always willing to help others and do anything for a neighbor. In his spare time, he loved watching football, and watching NASCAR races, both on TV and in person. He also had a tender spot for his own classic cars, especially his trophy Trans Am. Roger would take time each day to visit his friends and waitresses at Big Boy, where he would typically ask the server to "Surprise Me!" with his meals. Above all, Roger will be remembered for his unshakable Faith, which he put at the center of his life.

Roger is survived by his daughter, Lisa (Chad) Preston; granddaughter, Kira Gardner; and brother, William (Becky) Newcomb as well as many nieces and nephews He was predeceased by his wife, Janice Newcomb in 2015; his brother George (Cork), and his sister Barbara.

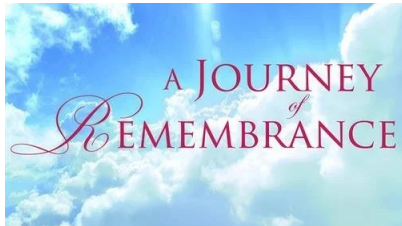

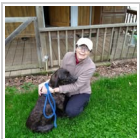
