Ronald Jay Beebe, 53, of Charlotte, died peacefully at his home on Thursday, January 26, 2017. Ron was born April 26, 1963, in Charlotte, the son of Gary and Midge (Gould) Beebe. Growing up he worked at the Village Cycle Shop, where he developed his mechanical inclination. Following graduation from Charlotte High School in 1981, he worked over 20 years with Alro Steel in Lansing and Potterville. Ron's passion for vintage snowmobiles found him working on them in his garage and riding together with his family. Notably, he and his brothers, nephews, and son took the trip of a lifetime snowmobiling through Yellowstone. He also loved home improvement projects, both large and small, around his house and garage. Ron enjoyed time in the outdoors, especially hunting and fishing. Many will remember Ron as a hard worker and a loving father, son, brother, and friend.

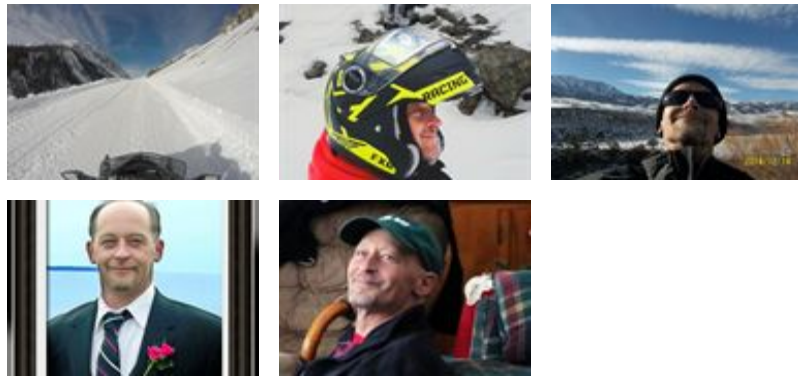
