Rose Ann Broskey, 71, a loving wife and mother, of Charlotte, died Thursday, January 6, 2023. Rose was born April 8, 1951, the daughter of Leo Clifford and Jeane Elaine (Hillis) Burt. She graduated from Charlotte High School and soon after met her husband, Roger Broskey, upon his return from the Vietnam War. They married on July 19, 1969 and together the two started and raised a wonderful family over 47 years.

Rose held many part time jobs throughout the years, including a stint on the production line at Linn Products in Charlotte when Roger got injured on the job. Most of her lifetime, however, she was home with the family. She even became the family barber, cutting Roger's hair, then the children's, and eventually extended family and friends when they needed perms, coloring, highlights, or anything else they were brave enough to let her try.

Rose and Roger enjoyed spending time together as members of the Eagles Club, country music events, hunting and fishing, kids school events, and trips to the casino. Rose inherited a love for music from her father who played the banjo, and taught herself to play the accordion, mandolin, and picked on her dad's banjo. They loved the bluegrass festival at the Eaton County Fairgrounds. She was the primary caregiver to dad in his later years as well as her mother, sister, and many other family members in their times of need. Rose was known to have a gruff exterior, but all who knew her well would say

she had a huge heart of service to her family and friends. Rose would "tell it like it is," which those closest to her came to admire and respect. She was extremely proud of her 7 grandchildren. She loved hearing about their adventures and supporting them in any way she could.

Rose is survived by her son, Allen (Shannon) Broskey of Howell, MI; daughter, Angel (Jeffrey) Bushman of Charlotte, MI; seven grand children, Caleb Phillips, Joe (Carly) Irish, Garrett Broskey, Colton Broskey, Kaitlin Irish, Seth (Grace) Broskey, and Corabella Bushman; brothers, David (Pam) Burt of Charlotte and Ed (Gerri) Burt of Fort Atkinson, WI; sisters-in-law, Mary (Denny) Geisenhaver and Myra Little; and several nieces and nephews.
