Sally Raines, 56, of Lake Odessa, died unexpectedly on Monday, May 15, 2017 at her home. Sally was born August 17, 1960, in Charlotte, the daughter of Harley D. and Bernadine May (Smalley) Raines. She graduated from Charlotte High School in 1978, and was a star player in softball and basketball. Following graduation, she was employed for 17 years with General Aluminum while going to school. She received a bachelor's degree in criminal justice from Michigan State University then began her 20 year career as an investigator at Ionia State Prison. Sally remained a loyal Spartan fan and enjoyed time playing golf. Above all, she will be remembered for her close friendships, which she considered family.

Sally is survived by her siblings, Cindy Raines, Sandy Davis, and Brian Raines; nieces and nephews, Casey Raines, Josh Raines, Greg Davis, Tasha Davis, Dylan Tokar, Kara Raines, Lillian and Raya; and many extended family and beloved friends. She is predeceased by her parents and her sister, Paula Mae Raines.

Funeral services will be held at 11:00 a.m. on Saturday, May 20, 2017 at Pray Funeral Home. Visitation will be from 2-4:00 p.m. and 6-8:00 p.m. on Friday, May 19, 2017 at the funeral home.
