Sue Ann Worden, 58, of Charlotte, a loving wife, mother, and grandmother, died suddenly on Sunday, February 20, 2022. 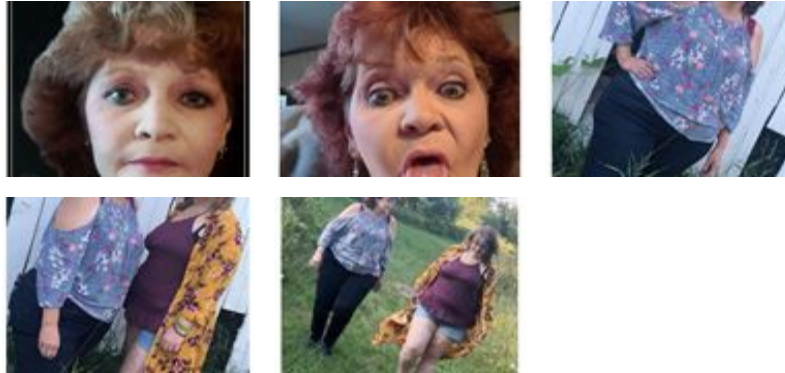
