



## Theodore "Ted" Myers

December 15, 1943 - November 1, 2016

Theodore "Ted" Myers, 72, of Charlotte, was called home by the Lord on Tuesday, November 1, 2016. Ted was born December 15, 1943 in Charlotte, the son of Rex and Lucille (Wilson) Myers. He graduated from Charlotte High School and enlisted in the U.S. Air Force, serving in Vietnam during the Vietnam War. Following his honorable discharge, he returned home and went to work for General Motors, retiring after over 30 years. In his retirement, he opened Ted's Tax Service, which he operated for nearly 25 years. Ted was a very active lifetime member of Maple City VFW Post 2406 in Charlotte, serving as Commander and Treasurer. He and his fiancé, Janet DeGroot, actively participated in Family Community Education and enjoyed time spent together at Pine Lake Resort. Ted was also a devoted member of Nashville Baptist Church. He enjoyed Thursday mornings traveling with his buddies playing golf. He was a big MSU fan, and enjoyed watching his grandchildren's sporting events. Above all, Ted loved his family.

Ted is survived by his fiancé, Janet DeGroot; daughter, Kim (Brian Bonney) Rodriguez; sons, T.R. (Maryellen Powers) Myers and Mark (Patty) Myers; 16 grandchildren; 5 great-grandchildren; and several nieces and nephews. He was predeceased by his parents and his 3 brothers, Lester, Robert and Gordon Myers.
