Trayce William White, 18, loving "Protector" of his sisters Taylin and Stormy, of Vermontville, died unexpectedly on May 14, 2019 in Hastings, MI. Trayce was born November 11, 2000 in Lansing, the son of Blane White, Jr. and Julie (Villanueva) White. On track to graduate through Michigan Virtual Charter Academy in June 2019, Trayce had a high SAT score and was planning on studying to be an aerospace engineer at the University of Michigan, where he had been accepted for the fall term. He loved music, bonfires, hunting, fishing, and bow hunting. Trayce was a great tinkerer and inventor; he could make something out of nothing. His big heart prompted him to help his sisters; he always wanted to make things better for them. Trayce was proud of how he could take care of things, in spite of a difficult life. He was a huge prankster, often comical, and very stubborn.

Trayce is survived by his mother, Julie White of Vermontville and his father Blane White, Jr. of Vermontville; siblings, Ashley (Matt) Hart of Potterville, Chantz (Megan) McManamey of Hastings, MaKayla Dickinson of West Seneca, New York, Taylin White of Vermontville, and Stormy White of Vermontville; and Papaw Blane (Gramma Deb) White, Grandmother Sue Villanueva, and Grandpa Alex Villanueva; several nieces and nephews; aunts and uncles; and first and only love Kalin Foster. 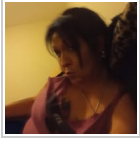
