October 21, 1915 - January 29, 2016

Violet Esther Morrow, 100 years of age, of Holdrege, Nebraska, formerly of Charlotte, Michigan, passed away on Friday, January 29, 2016 at the Christian Homes Care Community in Holdrege, NE. Violet was born October 21, 1915 in Phillips, NE, the fourth of eight children born to Elim and Tillie (Bjorklund) Youngberg. Shortly after her birth, the family moved to Gothenburg, NE. She received her primary education and graduated from Gothenburg High School with the class of 1932. After teaching school, she attended Trinity College in Deerfield, Illinois from 1935-1938. From 1939 to 1944, she worked with the Evangelical Mountain Mission in Eastern Kentucky. Violet pursued higher education and received her Master's Degree in Christian Education from Wheaton College in Wheaton, Illinois in 1950.

Violet taught Release Time Bible classes in The Dalles, Oregon for two years. She later worked as the Dean of Women at Trinity International University in Deerfield, Illinois. In 1959 she was united in marriage to Rush T. Morrow. She was an active member of the First Baptist Church in Charlotte, Michigan, participating in many leadership and mentoring endeavors.
