



## William Milton Adams

July 21, 1922 - September 4, 2003

Adams, William 81 of Scottsdale, Arizona, died at his residence on September 4, 2003. William, a long time resident of Royal Oak and Rochester Hills, Michigan, was a World War II veteran serving with the 10th Armored Division in Europe. After graduating from Michigan State College (University) in 1946 with a Journalism degree, William spent his entire 34-year career in the field of industrial public relations and publicity. Eighteen of those years were spent with General Motors Public Relations. Bill and his wife were members of the First Presbyterian Church of Royal Oak for over 40 years.
