William Bruce Crittenden, 83, of Charlotte died Sunday, August 16, 2015 after a short illness. He was born June 30, 1932 to Jay and Eleanor (Hill) Crittenden in Lansing, MI. He graduated from Michigan State University in 1952 with a degree in Agriculture and married his sweetheart Marilyn Medcoff on July 31, 1954. He was drafted in the Army, entering on August 2, 1955, and served for two years. Together Bill and Marilyn raised four children on their farm. In addition to farming, he was a tax assessor for many years. He was a member of Eaton Farm Bureau Co-op, and received the highest award available through the Future Farmers of America, the American Farmer Award, and was a long-time member of the First Baptist Church in Charlotte. In his spare time, Bill loved to hunt, especially deer and pheasant. He was a family man, very proud of his children, grandchildren, and great-grandchildren.

Bill is survived by his wife of 61 years, Marilyn; children Beverly (Patrick) Day, Pamela (Michael) Cary, Gary (Diana) Crittenden, and Daniel Crittenden; 12 grandchildren, five great-grandchildren; and siblings Jacquelyn Hare, Lorraine Bronson, and Barbara Rolfe. He was preceded in death by his parents.

Funeral services are Thursday, August 20, 11 AM, at Pray Funeral Home, Charlotte, MI with Pastor Richard Wilford officiating.
